

Health and Illness

The Manager has the right to refuse admission onto the premises of any child who appears to be suffering from any illness where the child is unable to cope with the nursery day.

Please do not bring unwell children into the nursery as they will be sent home upon arrival.

Parents/carers will always be contacted if their child has a high temperature or needs constant adult attention.

We are currently following the guidelines set out by the Health Protection Agency which is displayed on the parent's notice board. If you have any queries regarding any health issues. Please contact them on 0191-5163333

If a child is prescribed medication they will be excluded from nursery for a minimum period of 24 hours to be monitored at home.

Any child that has had sickness or diarrhoea must be excluded from nursery for a minimum of 48 hours from the last bout.

Antibiotics given 24 hours prior to attending the nursery, is acceptable if the child is well enough to participate.

The nursery should be notified of any illness in order that other parents can be notified.

The nursery manager reserves the right to refuse admission or contact a parent to remove any child because of medical reasons.

Once a parent has been contacted the child's key person will comfort your child until collected. If the parents can not be contacted the first or second emergency contact will be contacted.

The nursery manager reserves the right to call for emergency assistance, if necessary, remove them to hospital and give permission for emergency treatment to be administered. If we have to take your child to hospital as a result of an illness or accident, we will do our utmost to inform you immediately (using the details on your Registration Form).

It is the responsibility of the nursery manager to contact the Health Protection Agency regarding any outbreaks of illness.
